

DRESS CODE

Arrowhead Country Club is an exclusive, private club which adheres to a relaxed, but conservative dress code. Tasteful and appropriate attire is expected at all times. Members are asked to not only willingly comply with the code, but to make their family and guests aware of the requirements and ensure that they comply. Our staff has been directed to uphold and enforce our dress code policy to allow for an enjoyable club experience for all.

GENERAL RULES

The required mode of dress is "Club Casual" unless otherwise specified. Should you or your guests be out of dress code you will be kindly asked to correct immediately. You will not be able to continue your play or practice until you are in compliance.

GOLF COURSE + PRACTICE AREAS

- Men must wear collared shirts with sleeves (including turtleneck and mock turtleneck), with appropriate length golf shorts or pants. All clothing should be neat and clean.
- Women may wear dresses, blouses or sweaters, skirts, slacks, golf shorts, and capris. Sleeveless shirts must have a collar but collared shirt is not required if it has sleeves. All clothing should be neat and clean.
- Denim and athletic clothing is not permitted on the golf course, including the practice areas.
- Leggings are allowed but must be knee length or full length.
- Golf shoes must have soft spikes, or be spike less, no metal spikes are allowed.

CLUBHOUSE

- Men may wear collared shirts, or tee shirts with sleeves (including turtleneck and mock turtleneck), with appropriate length golf shorts or pants. All clothing should be neat and clean.
- Women may wear dresses, blouses or sweaters, skirts, slacks, golf shorts, and capris. All clothing should be neat and clean
- Tasteful denim and athletic clothing may be worn in all areas of the Clubhouse.
- Leggings are allowed but must be knee length or full length.
- Headwear should be appropriate and forward facing while in the Clubhouse.
- Soiled clothing should be changed before entering all areas of the Clubhouse.
- Proper footwear must be worn at all times in all areas of the clubhouse except for the locker room.
- No swimsuits of any kind in the clubhouse.
- Scheduled events may have a special dress code.

TENNIS COURTS + ATHLETIC CLUB

- Men may wear collared shirts, tee shirts, or athletic wear with appropriate shorts or pants.
- Women may wear dresses, blouses or sweaters, skirts, skorts, slacks, shorts, and capris. Appropriate athletic tops are required at all times.
- Proper footwear must be worn at all times in the Athletic Club and tennis courts except for the locker room.
- No denim is allowed on the tennis courts or while working out in the Arrowhead Athletic Club.
- Leggings are allowed on the tennis courts and in the Arrowhead Athletic Club, must be knee length or full length.

Rules cannot be written to address every possible instance of inappropriate dress, examples include...

- No ripped, soiled, stained, frayed, cut off, or see-through clothing.
- No cropped tops, tube tops, halter or bra-type tops.
- No sweat pants in clubhouse.
- Undergarments should never be visible.
- Slacks and shorts must be worn at the waistline.

Final decision on appropriate attire will be at the discretion of Arrowhead Country Club Management.
